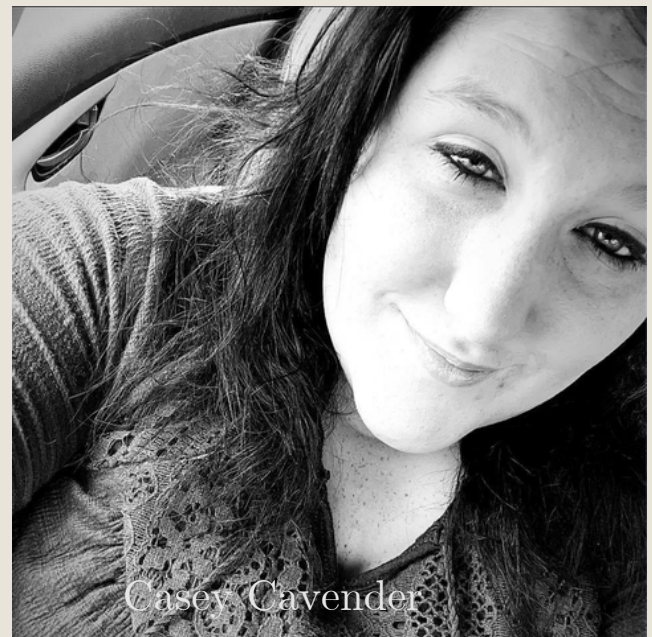

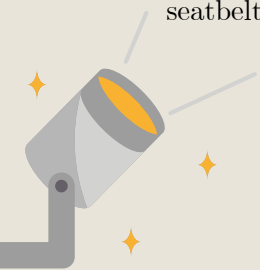

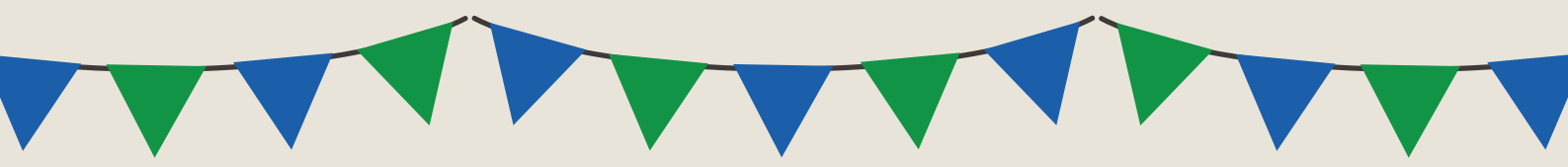

Ham and Cream Cheese Pinwheels!

Ingredients:

- 5 ounces chopped ham
- 1/3 cup cream cheese
- 1 can crescent rolls
- 1/2 chopped onion
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano

Preparation:

- Preheat Oven to 375 degrees.
- Mix ham, onion, cream cheese and oregano in a bowl until well combined.
- Separate the crescent rolls into 8 rectangles
- Spread an equal amount of cream cheese mixture over each rectangle.
- Roll up each rectangle starting from the short end.
- Cut each roll into four slices, place on a cookie sheet and press down slightly.
- Bake for 15-20 minutes.
- Serve and enjoy!
