# **Quarterly Party**







# From Pantry to Purpose: A Lifetime of Volunteering and the Birth of Story Street Pantry: by Loren Knauss



I've dedicated 38 years of my life to volunteering for church, government, and non-profit organizations. My journey started as a teenager, assisting my father, a Presbyterian minister, in stocking our church food pantry. This initial experience ignited my passion for volunteering, leading me to contribute my time and effort to various causes over the years.

Fifteen years ago, I began my involvement with the Our Savior's Lutheran Food Pantry in Council Bluffs, thanks to my friend Josh Weesner, the pantry's director. He convinced me to help deliver food, a role I continue to fulfill without interruption.

In 2018, while waiting to collect food from the Food Bank for the Heartland, Josh and I brainstormed a new food pantry structure. This innovative idea, initially sketched on a yellow post-it-note, aimed to connect multiple pantries and enhance accessibility. We envisioned a mobile food pantry trailer, a concept that lay dormant until 2020 when we decided to create a non-profit food pantry named Story Street Pantry, after the location of Our Saviors Lutheran Food Pantry.

Originally, we planned a gradual three-year implementation, but the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic accelerated our timeline. The pandemic significantly increased the demand for food pantry services. Responding swiftly, we opened new pantries in South Omaha and Carter Lake within three months. We also established a mobile pantry services team and introduced a mobile food pantry trailer, equipped to carry up to 4,000 lbs of non-perishable food items.

During the height of the pandemic in 2021, we transformed from operating a single pantry in Council Bluffs to collaborating with four fixed-site pantries in Council Bluffs, South Omaha, Carter Lake, and Oakland. Additionally, our mobile food pantry served over 10 locations monthly in the Council Bluffs area, including two schools. Our efforts bore fruit, as we provided services to over 90,000 people in the Council Bluffs/Omaha metro area and Southwest Iowa. Remarkably, we achieved this milestone without any paid staff, with my personal contribution amounting to over 3,000 volunteer hours in 2021.

While the need decreased in 2022 as people returned to work, we still assisted over 45,000 individuals, a substantial increase from our 2020 numbers. Our operations rely on a dedicated team of 30 to 200 volunteers each month, depending on their availability.

Currently, I serve as the chairman of the Story Street Pantry board of directors. We are in the process of transitioning our mobile pantry services to extend our assistance throughout Southwest Iowa, aiming to make a lasting impact in the communities we serve.

# Continuing Education

In October, AmeriServe proudly marked the 9th anniversary of its Employee Stock Ownership Plan (ESOP), a testament to our commitment to fostering shared success within our organization. Established nearly a decade ago, the ESOP was designed to empower our dedicated employees, allowing them to become stakeholders in the company's prosperity.

Over the years, the collective efforts of our remarkable team members have propelled AmeriServe's growth, paralleled by the increasing value of our ESOP shares. In fact, the share price has experienced an impressive 45% average growth over the past nine years, underscoring the thriving trajectory of our company. As a result, AmeriServe is now proudly 100% employee-owned, a testament to the power of collaborative ownership.

What sets our ESOP apart is its accessibility. Employees are not required to make any financial contributions to participate in the plan. To be eligible, an employee must be at least 21 years old, have completed a year of service at AmeriServe by the plan entry date, and have worked a minimum of 1,000 hours during that period.

Currently, 105 of AmeriServe's dedicated employees meet these qualifications and are active participants in the ESOP. Moreover, many others within our workforce have met, or will soon meet, these criteria and will join the plan in 2023 and 2024. This inclusive approach to ownership has not only provided significant retirement benefits for our participants but also exemplifies AmeriServe's unwavering commitment to its employees.

## ASI Cookbook Recipe of the Month!

#### Chicken Potpie

#### Ingredients:

- 3 cups of cooked shredded chicken.
- 2 10.5oz cans of cream of chicken soup.
- · 3 cups of frozen vegetables.
- 2 tsp minced garlic.
- 1/2 tsp ground black pepper.
- 1 cup shredded mild cheddar cheese.
- 1 cup shredded mozzarella cheese.
- 16 canned biscuits.
- 2 tbsp. melted butter.



#### Directions:

- 1.) Preheat Oven to 375 degrees, and spray 13x9 inch baking dish with non stick spray.
- 2.) In a large bowl, combine chicken, cream of chicken soup, frozen vegetables, and shredded cheeses. Mix until combined, then pour the mixture into the baking dish.
- 3.) Open the cans of biscuits and cut each biscuit into quarters, then place in a large bowl. Drizzle the melted butter over the biscuits and toss.
- 4.) Bake the biscuits on a slightly greased baking sheet for about 5-7 minutes.
- · Add the biscuits on top of the chicken mixture. Bake uncovered for 20-25 minutes/
- 5.) Let cool. Then serve and enjoy!
