





ASI Cookbook Recipe of the Month!

Pan Fried Cinnamon Bananas



Ingredients:

- · 2 Bananas cut into 1/2-inch pieces.
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon.
- 1 tbs butter.
- 2 tbs raw honey or regular honey.

Directions:

- 1.) Combine the cinnamon, butter, and honey in a frying pan over medium high heat until melted and combined.
- · 2.) Add the banana slices and cook 4 minutes until the bottoms start to caramelize and turn golden brown. Adjust the temperature and cooking time as needed so that they don't burn.
- Flip all the banana pieces and cook for another 4 minutes until the other side is golden brown.
