Rhonda expresses her gratitude for the support she receives, acknowledging that it has played a pivotal role in her pursuit of academic goals.





ASI Cookbook Recipe of the

Month!

Ingredients:

- 16 mini frozen pancakes
- 8 sausage patties (cooked)
- 4 eggs
- 1 tbsp of milk or cream
- · 2 tbsp of butter
- · 2 tbsp of maple syrup

Breakfast Sliders



Directions:

- 1.) Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Lay the frozen pancakes apart on a baking sheet. While the pancakes are warming up scramble the eggs with the milk and cook over medium heat, stirring frequently, until the eggs are cooked through.
- 2.) Combine the syrup and butter in a bowl and microwave for the 20-25 seconds or until butter is melted.
- 3.) After 7-9 minutes the pancakes should be warmed through. Remove the pancakes from the oven and brush the bottom of 8 pancakes with the butter and maple syrup mixture.
- 4.) Add a sausage patty to the pancakes already brushed with butter and syrup.
- 5.) Add eggs to the top of the sausage patty.
- 6.) Top each slider with the remaining pancakes.
